GPA 2172-08, Calculating Gross Heating Value, Relative Density, Compressibility and Potential Hydrocarbon Liquid Content for Natural Gas Mixtures for Custody Transfer, is currently being balloted through the GPA Technical Committee. We have asked that ballots be returned no later than June 28. With no negative ballots, the standard should be ready to publish in early July.
